Remember, if the training is not completed your network account will be suspended until you complete the training. The completion date is **July 31, 2020.**

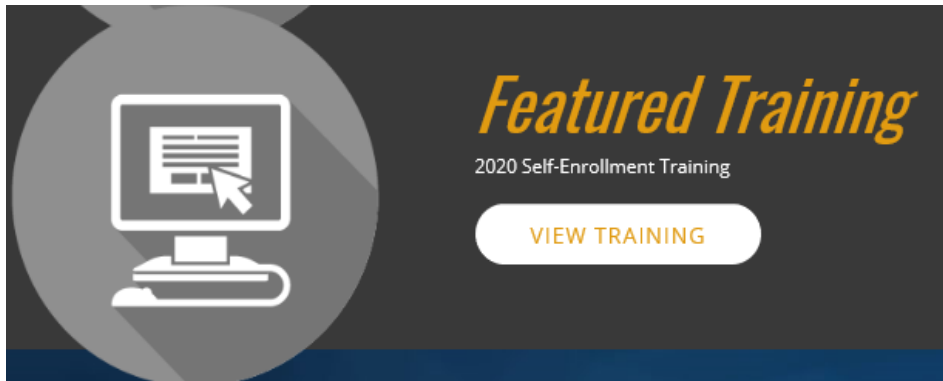

Self-Enrollment Information

1. All enrollments should be routed from the examiner to LearnCenter through self-enrollment. A refresher e-learning of the self-enrollment process is featured on the dashboard in LearnCenter. The e-training is on the dashboard in LearnCenter as the picture below.



2. There is no cap on the number of participants for the FFIEC Online training, therefore all **approved requests will be granted.**
3. There is no additional cost for the FFIEC Online training, therefore there is no budgetary impact to NCUA for the training.
4. Employees should review course descriptions and prerequisites in the [FFIEC catalog](#) prior to selecting courses. Many courses have prerequisites and pre/post-course assignments.

Please ensure you familiarize yourself with all pre and post-work for learning purposes and time management purposes. Since enrollment does not require supervisory approval, there should be verification from supervisors all prerequisites have been completed.
